PRIVATE PILOT GROUND SCHOOL COURSE TRAINING COURSE OUTLINE

Florida Aviation Career Training, Inc. (FACT.) is located on Northeast Florida Regional Airport (St. Augustine) at 4900 US1 N, Suite 200, St. Augustine, FL 32095

COURSE TITLE: Private Pilot Ground School Course

This training course outline meets all the requirements for Private Pilot knowledge contained in Appendix B of 14 CFR Part 141.

The Jeppesen Guided Flight Discovery Private Pilot Training Syllabus will be utilized, included with this outline, contains a separate ground training section and a flight training section, which are to be taught concurrently.

Course Objective:

The student will obtain the knowledge necessary to meet the requirements for a Private Pilot aeronautical knowledge test.

Course Completion Standards:

The student must demonstrate through knowledge tests, and show through appropriate records that he/she meets the knowledge, skill and experience necessary to obtain a private pilot certificate with an airplane category rating and a single engine class rating.

Ground Instructional Facilities:

Primary ground instruction facilities are a training room of approximately 15' by 30' equipped with tables and chairs adequate to accommodate 15 students as depicted in Figure A. This room is also equipped with two 48" by 96" dry erase boards and a TV/VCR unit for presentation of video training programs. The classroom is well lighted and thermostatically controlled, conforms to local building, sanitation and health codes and is designed so the occupants will not be disturbed by the activities in other rooms or by flight and maintenance operations on the airport.

A ground instructor assigned to this course must hold at least a Ground Instructor Certificate with Basic or Advanced rating.
